## Sport England England Child and Parent Survey

Sport England are looking to find out about the sorts of sports and physical activities that children and young people in Years 1 to 11 take part in, both in and out of school. For the youngest children, in Years 1 and 2, they would like to ask parents about what types of activities their children take part in, including cycling, walking, dance and sport. The information collected through the survey will help Sport England to invest in opportunities for children and young people to take part in and benefit from sport and physical activity.

**Our school has been selected to take part in this research. The year groups selected at our school are 1, 2, and 3.**

Your child will be asked to complete a very simple online questionnaire designed especially for children of their age. They will have an individual questionnaire but will be completing it on iPads with all the children from their class. They will do the survey in small groups at a suitable time decided by their teacher.

If you **do** not wish your child to take part in the survey please inform their class teacher.

**In addition, Sport England would also like you, as a parent, to complete an online questionnaire which will take about 20 minutes.** This will supplement the answers your child gives with more detailed information and will help to build a broader picture of activities done by children of this age. You can complete the survey at home and many parents find it helpful to complete the survey with their child present. There is an added incentive for completing the online survey. Sports England will make a monetary donation for sports equipment to the school. So, if you can spare time in your busy schedules, we would greatly appreciate it. Your opinions are also greatly valued so it is an opportunity to share them.

We have put the **link to the parent questionnaire on the school mobile App**, so all you have to do is press the link <http://ipsos.uk/PKD0ZKX> and it will take you straight there.

Please complete this survey thinking about your child and the class they are in. **Please complete by the 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2018.**

If you have more than one child in a year group, you can complete the survey twice, for each child or complete the survey once, for the child whose name is first in the alphabet.

Ipsos MORI will store your child's information securely and keep it confidential. The County Sports Partnership and Sport England will know which schools and year groups have taken part but they will not know which individual children or parents have taken part. You and your child will not be required to provide your names.



Your answers will be combined with other people's answers and only anonymous data will be reported. The results will be presented in a statistical report and no individual child, parent or school will be identified in the published report or statistics. The school will receive a copy of the report, which will help us to identify any areas we need to develop.
