Mobile Phones - Important

We have become increasingly concerned about the amount of phones coming into school and the safeguarding issues surrounding this on the playground before and after school. While we understand some children may bring their phones into school for safety or logistical reasons, mobile phones should never be used by the children on school property. Previously, permission to bring the devices in, would have been given through a letter to the head of school but from Easter, this permission will cease.

From 8th April, before your child brings a phone into school a contract will need to be completed by you and your child stating the reason why they need a phone in school. Your child can collect a blank contract from their class teacher. If Mr Newberry grants the permission, you will be issued with a sticker for the phone case so we know it is an approved device.
