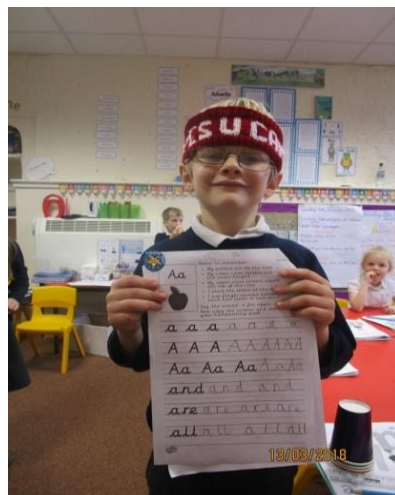
### DGAT



Maths is one of the key areas in school that we are currently working on with children and staff.

Through the on-going support from DGAT we have been really lucky to have had another inspirational speaker in school. Dave Bowman who works with GLOWMaths (Gloucestershire, Oxfordshire and Worcestershire hence GLOW) delivered staff training here last week. He embraces a “YesUCan” approach and the power of **Yes!** I am sure your children have come home talking about the YesUCan headbands we have in class; these are used when children and adults feel that they can’t do something - we say instead they “can’t do it yet” and “YesUCan”. This approach also deepens our Christian value of perseverance and is supported by our song “Try”, which we sing in worship. To increase our Maths learning and progress we are embracing this method that works hand in hand with Growth Mindset approach, which we are developing as a school. Part of the support that we have will help the children to take maths to a new level by developing their skills and teach for mastery through the ‘Try it, Use it, Prove it method’.

Mrs Walker had the opportunity to visit Bibury School with Mrs Kelly this week, which is very similar to our school at Coaley as it also has mixed age classes. The focus for the visit was to enable Mrs Walker to see another mixed EYFS/KS1 class and share good practice between the two schools.
