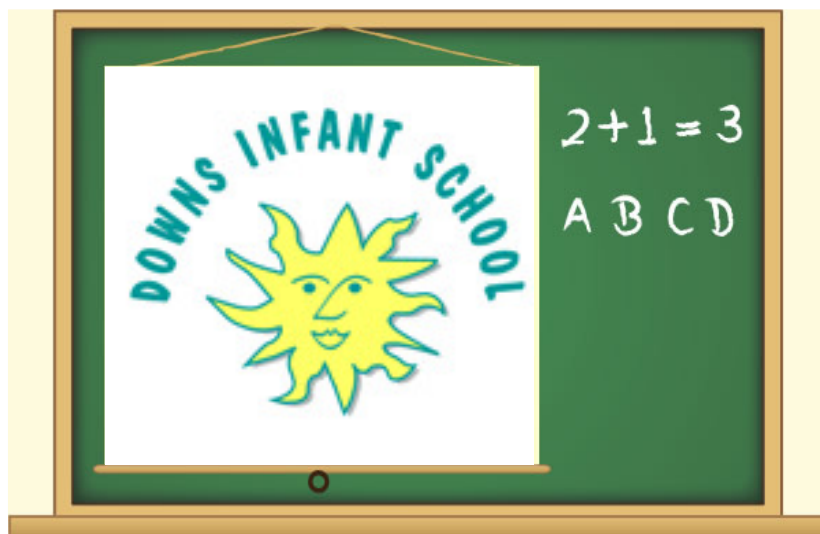


Downs Infant School Newsletter

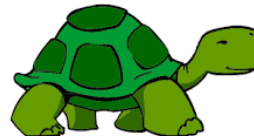
