- To ensure that those responsibilities laid down under relevant Education Acts relating to the Conduct of the School and Curriculum are being met.
- To monitor and assist in the administration of the following:
 - To ensure that the school is meeting the requirements of the National Curriculum
 - Special needs in relation to education and welfare
 - Religious education and collective worship
 - Race equality
 - Sex education
 - Pastoral care
 - Healthy Schools
 - Educational visits
 - School prospectus
 - School uniform
 - Pupil disciplinary matters
 - Any other pupil related matters deemed appropriate.

Quorum

Three members of this committee must be present for the meeting to go ahead

Terms of Reference

- To assist in the production, review and rewriting of policy documents which cover the delivery of the curriculum and the approaches adopted to teaching and learning within the school
- To agree, in consultation with the Headteacher, targets for the achievement of pupils at the end of Key Stage 2 and review levels of attainment and progress at last Standards Meeting of the academic year.
- To assist in the production and review of the School Development Plan
- To review, contribute and make recommendations as appropriate to the full Governing body on:
 - The review of the school's aims and objectives

- The provision for religious education and collective worship
- The race equality policy
- The sex education policy
- The assessment arrangements for pupils at the end of each key stage
- Reporting arrangements to parents
- The pupil behaviour and discipline policy
- To consider any amendments to the Home/School Agreement for recommendation to the full Governing body
- To ensure that the requirements for children with special educational needs are met
- To create a rolling programme to review policies other than those curriculum related
- To support the Executive Headteacher in matters of staffing ,where appropriate
- To pass on the minutes of the meetings to the members of The Resources Management Committee
- To ensure the school is meeting the requirements of The Equality Act 2010 and to review the policy for Inclusion
- To ensure the school complies with the Child Protection Act and Safeguarding of Children and to review the policies regularly
- To report to the full governing body at each of its meetings
- To review Terms of Reference at the first meeting each year of the Standards Committee.
