Policy on Personal respect

At St Peter's, our Head Teacher, Class Teachers and all support staff work hard to deliver high quality education within a safe, secure environment. 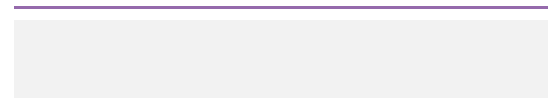
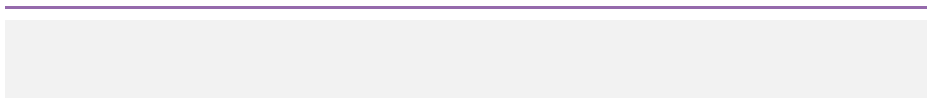
