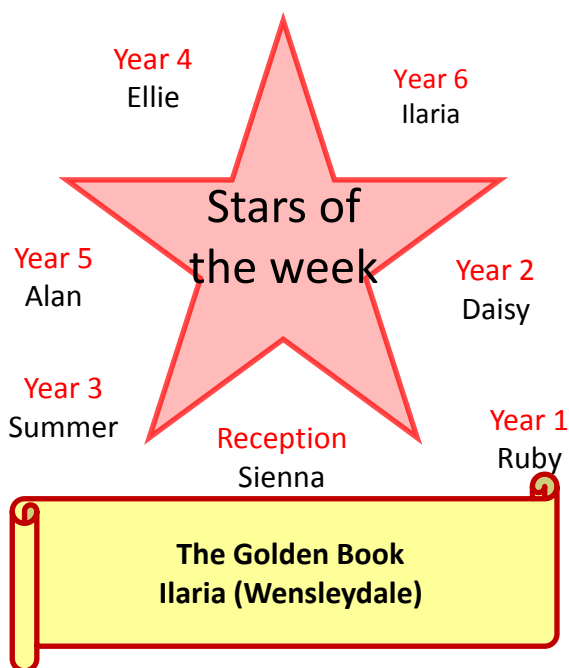

Learning to Play the Organ

The Diocesan Music Department has been running an Organists Training Programme and is looking to expand into Skipton. At the moment the programme teaches 35 students each year, about three-quarters are school pupils and one-quarter adults. Later this year they are looking to double that capacity to 70 across the Diocese, both school children and adults (including those who play the piano and would welcome tuition on the organ). Fr Andrew is very happy that the organ at St Stephen's can be used for the tuition and the Tutor would be available at the end of the school day.

Without any commitment at this stage, if you think you might be interested and to receive more information (any level of interest, experience or expertise is welcome), please contact Fr Andrew or Mr Pye before 24 March 2018. The programme is supported by grants and so the costs will be either non-existent or very low. It would be great from a School and Parish point of view to develop a pool of musicians.
