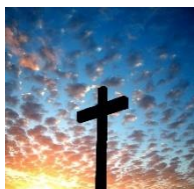


Attendance

LPS Expansion Plans



Planning permission for the site was given on 16th March subject to standard conditions. This means that the work can be put out to tender and there will be no significant changes to the structures.

It is proposed that creation of a safe working site to the area at the front of the School will be commenced during the next half-term, week beginning 28th May. This will become the new EYFS suite and is to be Phase 1. We have asked the architects for a large copy of the site plan to be made available for display in School.

New routes in and out of the site, pedestrian and vehicular will be established and everyone's co-operation will be essential to maintain safety throughout the project.
