


WRIGGLES & GIGGLES

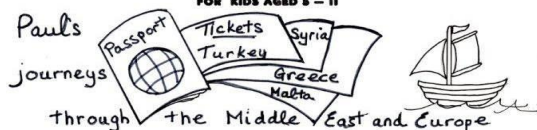
