

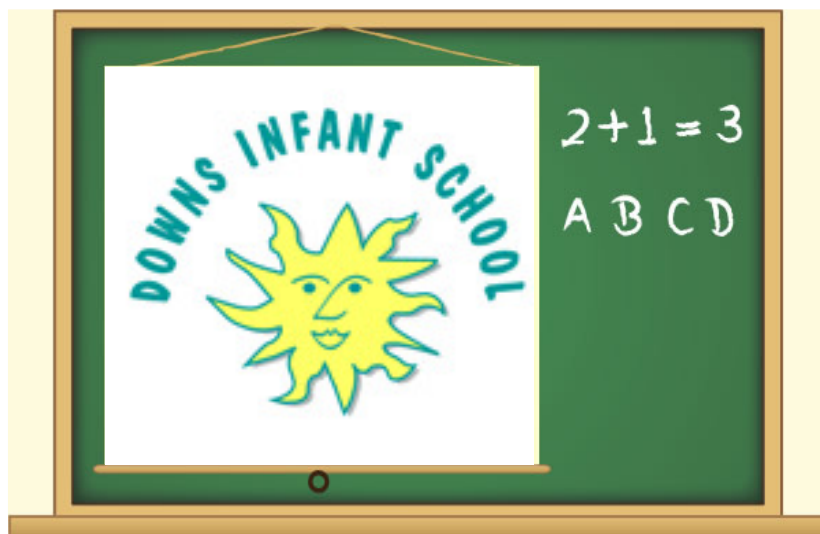
# Downs Infant School Newsletter

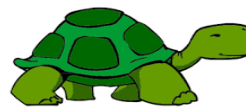
## IMPORTANT SAFETY NOTICE
