Mobile Phones

- We have already had issues of children upset because they have been told that their phone is not good enough.
- Accusations over damage.
- Children ringing home at lunchtime to say they are upset.
- A nearby school has dealt with photos being taken in a toilet.
- Phones are now the cause of most child bullying in the UK.

Therefore

As all children should be met by an adult up to Y5:

- No child under Y5 can bring a phone to school. Y4 may not bring them.
- Any phone not handed in will be confiscated and only handed back to a parent.
- The child will not be allowed to bring a mobile phone in again.
