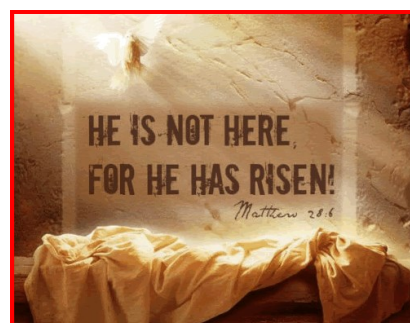
BKC AFTER SCHOOL ABSENCES
