- Year 2 performed beautifully in the 'Dance at the Dome' event recently with their amazing Shrek themed costumes and choreography.

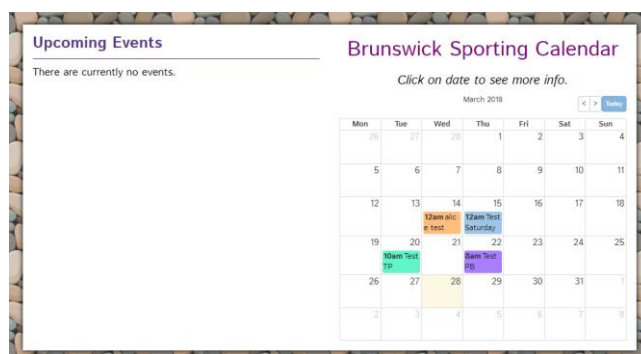
