Dear Parents/Carers,

In order to launch next half term's topic, Lyminster Through Time, Year 3 and 4 will be visiting Worthing Museum to discover how our local area has changed over time. Also on this trip, linked to Geography, pupils will be walking around Worthing in order to observe and record human and physical features, considering how these have adapted and developed over the years.

We will be going to Worthing Museum on **Friday 27<sup>th</sup> April** via coach. To enable us to enjoy the full experience, your child must be at school by **8:40am** on that day, in full school uniform. The coach will be leaving by 9am in order for us to arrive at the museum by 9:30am. After the sessions, the coach will be picking us up at 12:15pm for us to be back at school by **12:30pm**. Your child, therefore, will need to bring a water bottle and snack but **not** a packed lunch.

Please ensure your child is dressed in warm school uniform clothes, with sensible, comfortable shoes and a waterproof coat. If your child suffers from travel sickness, please let us know and ensure your child takes medication prior to arrival at school. Staff can then ensure that they supervise the administration of further medication for the journey home if necessary.

We are asking Parents/Carers for a voluntary contribution of **£10** to cover the cost of the transport and other expenses to enable this trip to go ahead. Although the contribution is voluntary, if insufficient contributions are made, this trip may not go ahead. I appreciate that some families might find it particularly difficult to contribute all or part of the suggested sum, and if you feel that you are in such a position, please do not hesitate to contact Mr McGinley or Mrs Jones in confidence to discuss whether some suitable arrangements can be made to cover the cost of your child's participation.

We will need five volunteers to help us with this trip, so if you are willing to accompany us please complete the section on the permission slip attached. We will let you know as to whether your assistance is required by Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> April. All volunteers will be required to complete an 'Off-site visit Volunteer Agreement'.
