YEAR 1 WOW DAY

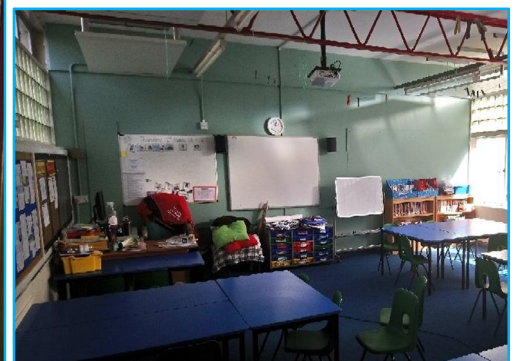
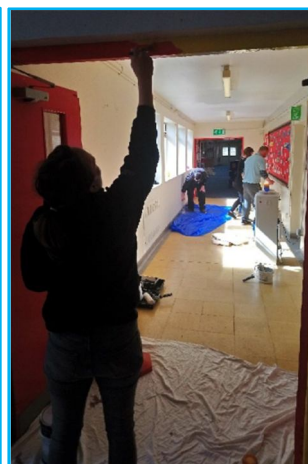
On Monday, Year 1 were very excited to spend the morning in the Wild Wood as a 'Wow' day to introduce their new enquiry 'How many legs?'
