Snow alert..



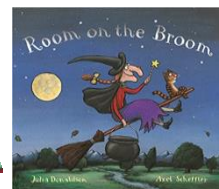
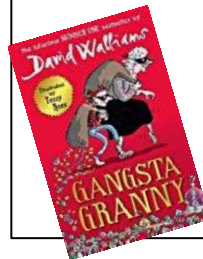
If we need to close the school due to heavy snow a text/email will go out to all parents/carers before 7am.
