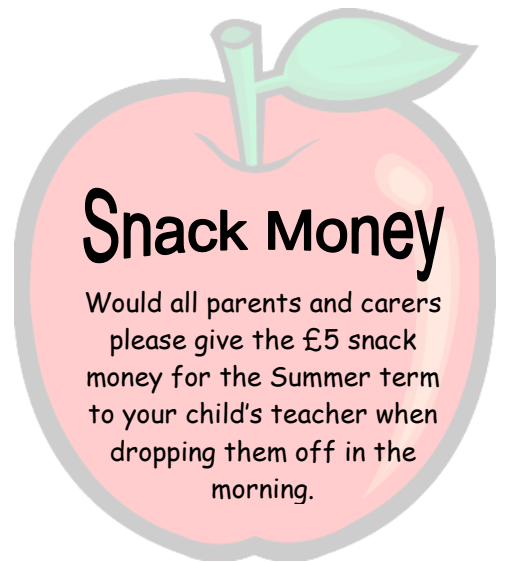
PE Kit
