A Right Royal Muddy Picnic/Non-School Uniform Day

We are pleased to announce that we will be holding an afternoon of fun starting with a picnic followed by an obstacle course on the school playing field. This will include a water slide, muddy crawl tunnels, climbing obstacles and lots more!

Children are invited to wear red, white and blue for the day to celebrate all things British the day before the Royal Wedding!



Family members are invited to join the children at school from **11:30 am** onwards for a lunchtime picnic. We will have an on-site DJ, and also a photographer with prints being available to purchase on the day. Also, there will be an ice cream van and food available (although you are more than welcome to bring your own picnic). You can then watch the children having fun on the obstacle course. An approximate guide of start times for each year group is as follows:

Year R – 1:15 pm
Year 1 – 1:30 pm
Year 2 – 1:45 pm
Year 3 – 2:00 pm
Year 4 – 2:15 pm
Year 5 – 2:30 pm
Year 6 – 2:45 pm

As you can see, we aim to finish at the end of the school day, but please bear with us if we are running late!

'Muddy Mayhem' will be a sponsored event to raise money for a Traversing Wall for KS2 and new playground markings for KS1. We ask that completed sponsorship forms and monies are returned to the school by Friday 25 May.

We'd love for all the children to join in, however if your child does not want to participate they will be able to sit and watch during the activity. **Consent will need to be given via School Comms for your child to participate by Monday 7 May. If we have not received your consent, your child will not be allowed to take part. Parents may take their child home after they have taken part; if you plan to do this, please let your child's teacher know on the day with a note in their contact book. Please also let us know at the same time if you will be picnicking with your child.**

As this is a wet and muddy event it is important that the children wear clothing that you are happy to get quite messy. Therefore, for this event, we would advise that a set of clothes be brought into school on the day to change into rather than the children using their PE kits. However, if you are happy for your child to wear their PE kit, this is fine.

As with any PTA event we always require help to run the activities, so if you could spare us a few hours on the day to set up, man an obstacle or help clear away, we would be extremely grateful. **Please get in touch with us either via the school office or on the PTA Facebook page.**

After the children have had their fun, if any adults wish to have a go on the obstacle course they will need to see a member of the PTA to sign a disclosure form before starting.
