

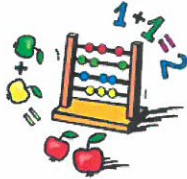


Year 6 - Summer Term 1



Maths

Our Maths work this term will involve applying our arithmetic skills to word problems. We will be looking at SATs type questions and working out which of the skills we have learned, would be needed in order to solve real life problems.



English

We will develop our reading comprehension, grammar, punctuation and spelling skills through our class novel "Goodnight Mr Tom". We have will write some amazing pieces of work based on this book and we will continue to apply our skills to a range of genres.



Science



Our Science topic this term is Light. We will be learning about how light travels, investigating how light reflects and how we see colour. We will also develop our knowledge of Isaac Newton and his discoveries about colour. We will plan different types of scientific enquiries to answer questions, including recognising and controlling variables where necessary.

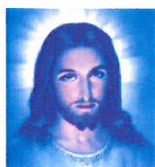
Theme this term will be history based.
