Maths

Our maths work will involve working on Decimals and Money. We will apply our skills through problem solving, challenges and maths reasoning.

Learning will be practical and fun. Children are encouraged to learn all their times tables and division facts.



English



In English lessons, we will be exploring a range of writing genres. We will immerse ourselves in stories, poems and many non-fiction types of work. We will then use this information to support our own writing. Also, we will be reading 'How to Train a Dragon'.

Science

Our Science topic this term is related to the digestive system and teeth. The children will be learning key facts, as well as creating practical investigations to test their ideas.



Themed Work - In from the Cold!

Theme this term will be connected to the Vikings and Anglo-Saxons. Children will be learning about the past and gaining a deeper understanding of historical types of evidence.
