General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) information to parents

• New Signing In/Out sheet

To comply with the new regulations coming into force on 25th May we have adopted a new signing in and out sheet for parents taking children out of school during school time or bringing them in after an early morning appointment. All children must be signed in and/or out of school by an adult. Over the next week or so we will be sending home updated paper work for you to complete which will comply with the above regulation. It is important to read all information and return it to school as soon as possible.

• Photographs in School

Please can we ask parents coming into our Celebration assembly on a Friday, to ensure you are only taking photographs of your child on their own and not photos of the whole group or class on the stage. We have children in school, for very justifiable reasons, who cannot be on photographs and these children can be on the stage when you are taking photos.

Please by all means carry on taking the photo of your child to share with family and friends but if you could position them on one of the benches away from other children that would be really helpful. If you need the class shot, then Mrs Borland always publishes the official one in the newsletter for you to download where we have removed any pupils who should not be on.

I hope you understand our position on this and support us in trying to take a sensible but reasonable one that keeps all our children safe.
