If meeting with the Headteacher does not resolve the complaint to your satisfaction, you will be advised to put your complaint in writing to the school's governing body. If your complaint remains unresolved, you may complain to the Secretary of State for Education asking to look into your complaint. The Secretary of State may not consider any complaints unless the above stages have been completed.
