Wet Mornings

According to the weather forecast we have a run of good weather ahead of us for the weekend and beyond. However, this is England and sooner or later it will rain in the morning again!

Please can I stress that although we do accommodate parents who arrive early by opening the main playground gates at 8:30am, **there is no requirement from the school or need for any child or parent to be on the school premises before 8:45am.** This applies particu-

larly on wet days where limited shelter means those arriving early will be open to the elements. I recommend that 8:45am (or just before) is the ideal time to arrive at school so that your children can enter directly into their classes.

The beginning of the day procedure allows all children to enter the building through their specific class doors during the period 8:45am to 8:55am without the requirement for lengthy waiting outside. Children and parents should rest as-

sured that those who enter their classrooms during that period are all 'on-time'.
