Dear Parents and Carers,

As you will be aware, we had special visitors from Ofsted in school last week. Our school was inspected as part of the usual rolling programme of inspections, and the report is due out in a week or so. Once it has been published I will be writing to you all to let you know how we plan to tackle the areas for improvement. I will also be inviting you to a meeting to allow you to discuss anything you wish.

KS1 and 2 SATs: These fall every year during the month of May. Children in Y2 have been working hard and have already completed some of the set tests. Y6 children will be tested between Monday 14th and Friday 18th May.

Parents' Evening: This will be held the first week back after the May half term holiday, but if you want to discuss anything with your child's class teacher before then, do not hesitate to contact us.

School uniform: reminder. Please don't forget that it is still the rule that children should wear suitable black shoes for school even when the weather is warmer. Trainers are allowed, but they **MUST** be plain black. All children must ensure that they have a correct PE kit in school at all times. This is black or navy shorts and a white t-shirt, with or without the school logo.

Don't forget that the new rule about earrings comes into force after the May half term holiday. **NO** earrings for children will be permitted in school after that date due to a number of recent accidents.

Out of School Club: Our out of school club currently has some vacancies. If you want to access high quality childcare before or after school or during the school holidays, either ring the office or pop into club to have a word with Maureen or Sandra. Over the half term holiday the club will re-locate from the current room to a permanent base in the KS2 building with a separate gate and designated outside area. Watch out for updates.
