As you are aware, SATs week will be starting on Monday 14<sup>th</sup> May and continue through to Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> May. Please find a copy of the SATs timetable below detailing the timings and nature of the tests on each particular day. If for any reason, you think that your child is going to be a few minutes late, please ring school as early as possible.

It is obviously quite an anxious week for the children; they will probably feel a little more tired in the evenings, compared to usual, and require lots of encouragement and support at home. Due to the nature of the week, we will try and make the afternoons as enjoyable, and a little more relaxing, for the children as physically possible. We would, therefore, be grateful if you could ensure that your child has their PE kit in school every day this week.
