

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Following a sickness bug in Foundation 2 last week we had over 50 children and two members of staff absent from school on Friday. Please be aware that the rules for keeping children off school for 48 hours since their last bout of physical sickness have to be followed to reduce the spread of germs across the classes. We always ensure classes where sickness has occurred are cleaned rigorously each night and on Friday, followed detailed guidance from the Public Health Department regarding a deep clean of all of the F2 classrooms.

We do all we can to support the children in keeping themselves clean and remind them about hygiene regularly. We need the support of parents with this, keeping children at home for the whole 48-hour period, as directed by the Public Health Department. This time period is not just our rule but theirs, as it ensures children are clear of all germs before they return to school. Thank you for your support- we hope that not too many of you were poorly over the long weekend!
