



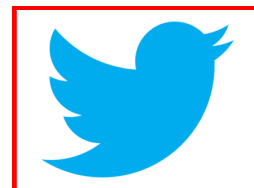

STAYING SAFE IN THE SUN

Now the sunnier days have arrived, please can I remind you of the importance of using sun cream to protect children's skin from the sun's harmful rays. It is important that children go out in the sun for their general health, but they should be using sun cream on a regular basis. If they can apply their own sun cream, they may bring it to school in a clearly labelled bottle and apply it to themselves. Alternatively, please ensure you apply sun cream before the school day.
