According to Public Health England a quarter of 5 year olds have tooth decay with an average of 3 or 4 teeth being affected. This leads to around 60,000 missed school days a year and causes problems with eating and sleeping. Children's tooth extractions are also one of the largest causes of hospital admissions in the UK.

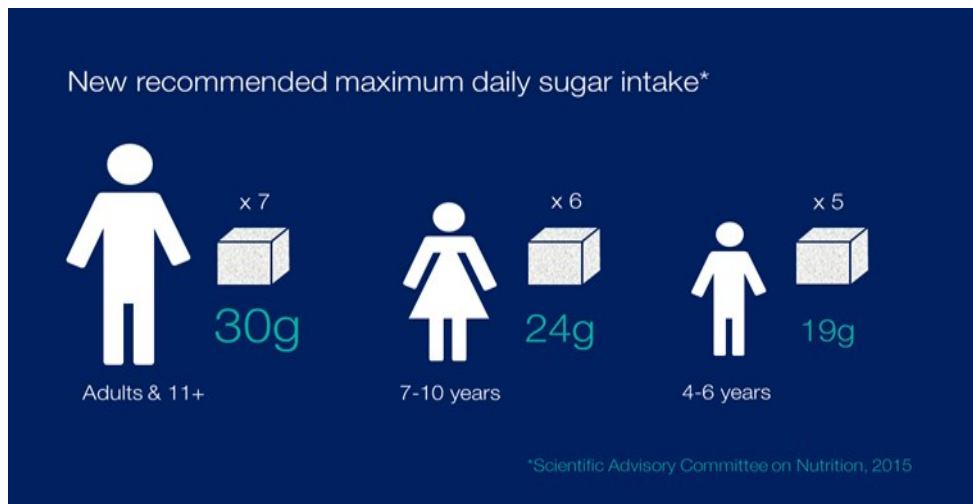
change 4 life campaign urges swapping sugary drinks to low or no sugar choices (A can of coke contains 8 spoons of sugar). Compare to the daily allowance age

It is recommended that you supervise your child/children cleaning their teeth at night and one other time. Ensure your child/children are registered with a dentist and visit the dentist every

6 months for a check-up (this is a free service for children under 18 years).
