In the Gospel this week we heard the story of the daughter of Jairus. Jesus was preaching to the crowds when Jairus came to him kneeling at Jesus' feet. He said "My little daughter lies at the point of death. Come and lay Your hands on her, that she may be healed and she will live." Jairus came to Jesus because he believed Jesus could help. Mrs Winnery explained that when a person believes God can do something that is faith. As they neared the house they received a message that the daughter had died. Jesus spoke to Jairus "Don't be afraid; just believe." When they arrived at Jairus' house Jesus reached out and took the girl by her hand. He spoke to her and said, "Little girl, I say to you, arise."

### Nursery visit to East Riddlesden Hall

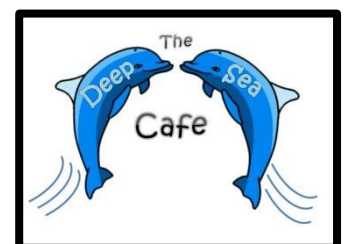
