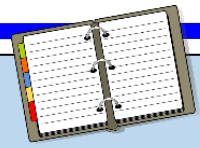
Altar Cloths

Please note that as of Term 1 the cost of school dinners will go up to **£2.20**. Please ensure that you are paying the correct amount if your child has school dinners. Many thanks

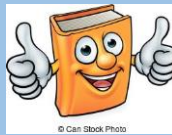


Library Closing for the Summer Holidays
