Extend your research skills:

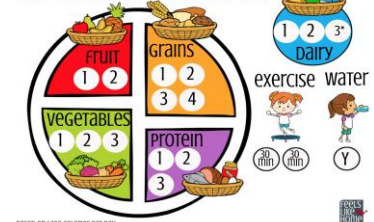
- ◆ Talk to your family and find out who was involved in WW2. What were their roles? Find photos and other special objects.
