Day Webster's managers are trained to provide support to employees and to support them throughout their employment life cycle with Day Webster.

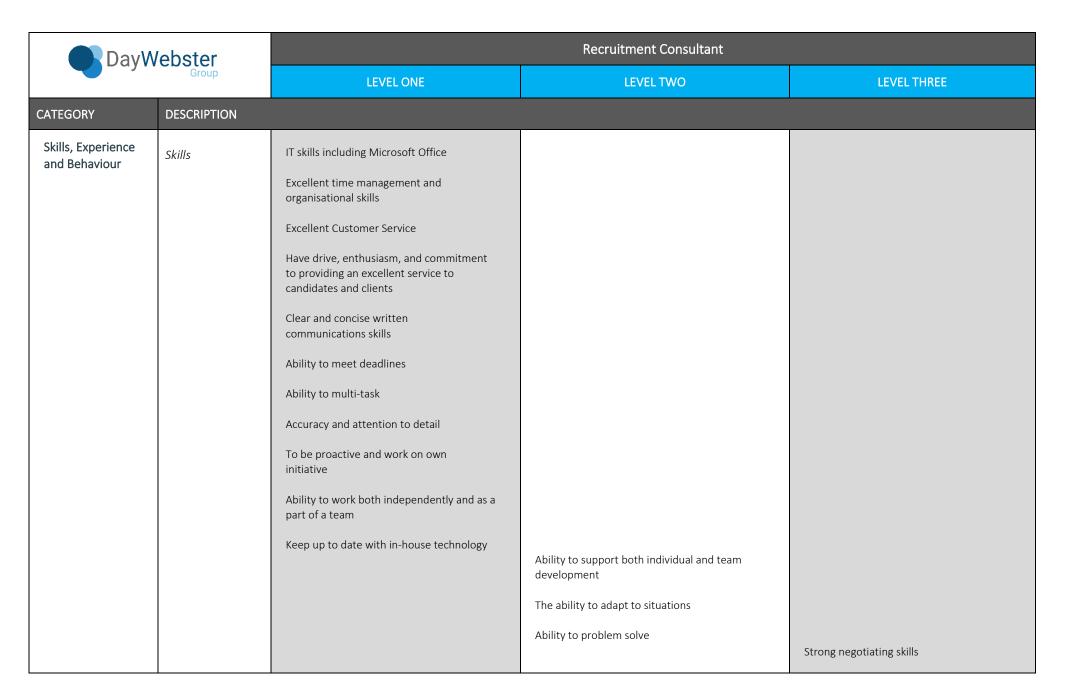
