Preparing for Your Application

Before visiting the bank, ensure you have all necessary documents in order and have a clear understanding of your business.

- **Complete documentation:** Gather all required documents, including those mentioned earlier.
- **Business plan:** While not always mandatory, having a well-structured business plan can strengthen your application.
- **Initial deposit:** Be prepared to make an initial deposit to open the account. The minimum deposit amount varies by bank.

- **Complete application forms:** Provide accurate and complete information on the application forms.
- **Submit documents:** Hand over the required documents to the bank representative.
- **Biometric data:** You may be required to provide biometric data (fingerprints and facial recognition).
- Initial deposit: Deposit the required amount to open the account.

Post-Application Process

- Account activation: Once your application is approved, the bank will activate your account.
