Dear Pastor and Praying Friends,

Psalm 121:7-8, "The Lord shall preserve thee from all evil: he shall preserve thy soul. The Lord shall preserve thy going out and thy coming in from this time forth, and even for evermore." God's promises are so sure and true, and I experienced His amazing protections again and again in the last few months.

On a Sunday morning I opened the gate to pull my car out. There was a loud bang behind me as I turned around to walk to my vehicle, and some objects were flying at me. One side of the gate fell down and part of it shattered. God's timing is ever perfect. If I had turned around one second later, I could have been killed. Each side of the gate was about seven by eight feet and made with metal. Praise the Lord also the gate did not fall while I crouched down to put a rock at the bottom to keep it open. God was so good keeping me safe.

After a Wednesday evening class I drove two siblings home as usual. Shortly after I left their house, I realized the temperature gauge was at high. Quickly I pulled over and tried to call for help but was not able to reach anyone. The mechanic was less than ten minutes away, but it was after nine o'clock at night. I decided to give it a try. While driving I prayed hard for God to help my car not to break down and to keep the mechanic there. The gate at the mechanic shop was open, yeah!! I pulled in, and the mechanic was still there, praise the Lord!!! There was a crack in the radiator. The mechanic strongly suggested I leave my car there. So how did I get home? God already had everything worked out. The mechanic's friend was there with a car, and they took me home. Isn't God so good?

In my last prayer letter, I requested your prayers concerning the new class at a secondary starting in January. I had three boys on the first day, and the class has grown to 15 in the last two months. About ten of them have been coming faithfully each Wednesday while the others come on and off. Since this is an after school Bible club, it is not always easy for the students to come every week. There are other programs going on at the same hour, and sometimes the students would have to go home right away on their parents' request. I talked to the head teacher of the school about switching it to lunch time. Please pray for Ms. Pamela as she discusses this with the principal.



In order to help the children at church sing unto the Lord better, I started a singing class in February. We have been learning different music symbols and singing in time and on key. In the future as the children gain more knowledge, I would like to teach them singing in parts. Music is not my greatest strength, but **"I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me," Philippians 4:13.** Please pray for God to give me wisdom and strength.
