Institute Graduation

We recently had the privilege of graduating two students from our Bible Institute. Incidentally, the two graduates were brothers, who had both been saved, baptized, and disciplined under the ministry of our church. Both of these men, Donn  and George, continue to be faithful servants in the church and are faithful soul winners. God gave me the opportunity to teach both of these men in the Bible Institute.



Discipleship Graduates

Though I do not personally work with the discipleship class, yet it blesses my heart to see these Christian men and women finish their discipleship lessons and become more involved in the church. This is a photo of some of our students, who have recently finished the discipleship program. Our discipleship program consists of 16 lessons that a student completes with the instruction of a teacher, as they work together, one on one, through each lesson. No one in our church is allowed to hold any position of leadership or even sing in our church choir unless they have successfully completed discipleship.



Baptisms

Baptisms are always not only a blessed occasion for our church, but they also mark a special milestone in the lives of our people. Most of our people, who get baptized, do so with or without the approval of their family. God allowed me the privilege of baptizing a couple (he is from South Africa and she is Malagasy), who had come from another church in the area. They had been looking for a Bible-believing, Bible preaching church for their family. God led them to visit our church, not quite a year ago, and they started the discipleship program. In the course of studying, they finished lesson 3, which covers baptism. They agreed to get baptized, by Baptist baptism, and their family continues to grow in our church. In fact, just last week, their daughter raised her hand for salvation. One of our faithful lady soul winners spoke with her after church, and she accepted Christ as her Saviour!
