SEO Survival Checklist – Post Google May 2025 Update

- 1. PageSpeed Score Above 90
 - → Run your homepage on PageSpeed Insights. Anything below 90 = at risk.
- 2. Mobile Load Time Under 2 Seconds
 - → Most traffic is mobile now. If your site lags, your rankings drop fast.
- 3. Avoid Full-Width Images Above the Fold
 - → Heavy hero banners are killing load speed. Use compressed or lazy-loaded media.
- 4. Eliminate Unused Plugins or Scripts
 - → Every extra plugin adds weight. Especially tracking scripts and third-party embeds.
- 5. Avoid Layout Shifts (CLS > 0.1 is bad)
 - → Make sure content doesn't 'jump' while loading. This is a major ranking signal now.
- 6. Reduce Fonts and Font Variants
 - → Custom fonts are silent killers. Stick to 1–2 fonts and only required weights.
- 7. Use a Lightweight Theme
 - → No matter how good your content is a bloated theme will destroy performance.
- 8. Don't Autoplay Video or Carousels
 - → Google now deprioritizes autoplay-heavy pages, especially on mobile.
- 9. Uptime Matters
 - → If your server goes down, even briefly, Google picks it up. Use uptime monitoring.
- 10. Cache + CDN in Place
 - → If your site isn't cached and globally distributed, you're loading too slow period.
