Dear Pastor and Praying Friends,

As the writer of Hebrews once said, “the time would fail me to tell” you of everything God has been doing for us and through us here in Madagascar. So much has happened since we last wrote, so let me give you a few highlights and let the pictures say the rest.

### English Bible Lessons:

Beginning at the end of June through the month of July we met once every two weeks (on Wednesday from 5 pm to 5:45 pm) to teach short Bible lessons in English. Averaging 8-10 students, we introduced different vocabulary words to them every week in order to teach a short Bible story at the end of study time. Our goal is that by the month of December the students will be able to tell the Christmas story in English during our annual Christmas program. Prayerfully, we will see the students’ family and friends come to that program.



### The Ambohibao Cup:

As many of you might know, the World Cup 2018 has ended. We also just finished our Spring Program at the end of August. Using the World Cup as inspiration for the program, we called it, “The Ambohibao Cup.” (Ambohibao is the neighborhood where the church is located.) We had different promotions each Sunday during the month

to try and get as many people as possible to come hear the Gospel. Teams of people went soul winning three days a week to pass out tracts. Of course, the devil fought us all the way, but God blessed with our largest day ever! Our last Sunday, “Malagasy Sunday,” we had Malagasy foods and the people dressed in traditional Malagasy clothes. That day, we hit an all-time high of 350 people in attendance that day! Please pray for fruit that remains from all of the labors of this program.

Thank you for all of your support and prayers, which enable us to do what we do in your stead here in Madagascar.
