

PRIVACY NOTICE CONCERNING PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING BY THE ORGANISER

Who is the Controller of your personal data?

The Controller of your personal data given by you at registration for the Event is **ING Business Shared Services B.V., with its registered office in Amsterdam, the Netherlands**, operating in Poland as a Branch under the business name **ING Business Shared Services B.V. limited-liability company Branch in Poland with its registered office in Katowice (IBSS)**, ul. Konduktorska 35, 40-155 Katowice, Tax Identification Number [NIP]: PL5263195854, National Court Register 0000702305 ("Organiser").

Why do we process your personal data?

Your personal data will be processed by us in order to let you participate in the Competition called the Lion's Den Risk Modelling Challenge ("Competition"), most notably in order to:

- process your application to take part in the Competition, your participation in the Competition and to provide you with updated information thereabout, inclusive of announcement of the Competition results, issue of Awards and processing of complaints, if any, related to organisation and course of the Competition; the legal basis for data processing is your consent and legitimate interest, namely running the Competition wherein you decided to participate;
- fulfil legal duties of the Controller related to running the Competition, inclusive of the statutory tax obligations, obligations resulting from the Act on Accounting, as well as for commercial and marketing purposes – the legal basis for data processing is your consent;
- promote the Competition and to build a positive image of IBSS in public space and in mass media, including publications on the website of IBSS, on IBSS profiles in social media, during conferences and fairs – the legal basis for your image data processing is your consent;
- execute any other legitimate interests of IBSS, inclusive of the right to sue or defend any claims, archiving purposes (evidence purposes) to safeguard information should it be needed to prove the facts;
- additionally, your personal data given at the registration for the event will be processed in order to learn about your satisfaction with the events organised by us (by sending a short questionnaire to you). The legal basis for processing of your personal data is the fact that they must be processed in order to effect the legitimate interest of IBSS, namely to maintain high quality of service and high satisfaction of the participants.

Who do we transfer your data to?

Your personal data may be transferred to:

- EventLabs Spółka z ograniczoną odpowiedzialnością [limited liability company], with its registered office in Warsaw, ul. Żurawia 6/12, 00-503 Warszawa [Warsaw] pursuant to the Data Processing Agreement, that processes the data as commissioned by the Organiser in order to register for the events organised by us through the portal www.eveneapl;
- ING Bank Śląski Spółka Akcyjna with its registered office in Katowice: ul. Sokolska 34, 40-086 Katowice in connection with organisation of the Competition, or any other entities from ING Group (that is, entities related in capital or personal terms with ING Groep N.V. with its registered office in Amsterdam, the Netherlands);
- public authorities and entities performing public tasks or operating at a request of public authorities, within the scope and for the purposes resulting from the commonly applicable legal regulations;



How long do we store your data?

We will not keep your personal data longer than necessary to achieve the goals for which they were collected or longer than provided by law, that is until the claims fall under the statute of limitations. Should you give your consent to sending marketing information to you, inclusive of information about consecutive events, your data will be processed until you cancel your consent.

What are your rights?

You have the right to access your personal data and you have the right to rectification, erasure, the right to restrict processing them, the right to data portability, the right to object to processing, the right to withdraw your consent any time without affecting lawfulness of the processing that took place based on your consent prior to its withdrawal.

Should it be found out that personal data processing infringes GDPR, you may file your complaint to the President of the Office of Personal Data Protection.

Giving your personal data is voluntary, however the marked personal data are indispensable in order to get registered and to participate in the event.

Please be informed that we do not apply any automated decision-taking, and your data are not profiled.
