We are also working with our venue, the Reform Club and its in-house event team, to make sure we can bring our delegates together in a safe and secure manner, while preserving engagement.

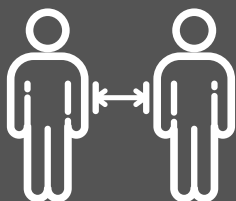
To ensure the event is safe for all attendees and to make sure you feel comfortable joining us, hedgeweek is committing to the following guidelines:



Working closely with government, local authorities and venues

Our first priority in hosting the hedgeweekLIVE: Better Business Summit as an in-person gathering, will be to work closely with government and the local authorities. The event will be planned carefully in accordance with current advice and guidelines.

The Reform Club has been home to hedgeweek events in previous years and, as such, we already have a close working relationship with key staff, who are committed to supporting a covid safe gathering.



Social distancing protocols

This event is designed to ensure our audience is comfortable in in-person social situations. We will follow every precaution in line with local guidance. We have selected a venue with a spacious ballroom and breakout rooms for individuals who are looking for more distance.

We are minimising the number of touchpoints at the event and reminding all delegates to maintain physical distancing where necessary. We are asking everyone to avoid handshakes (in favour of non-contact greetings) and are reducing queuing and other points of congestion.

The use of face covering is recommended for attendees who have yet to be vaccinated. Masks will be also available on the day upon request.

Please note: this is in line with current guidelines and could be subject to change as we get closer to the date of the event.



Sanitation and hygiene
