## Functionality

For each task, there are two possible values to enter each day.

If the box is left blank, it will remain white—this can be used for days when you intentionally leave certain tasks open, such as weekends when no mandatory tasks are scheduled. Feel free to adjust this based on your business needs and preferences.

At the end of each day, you'll receive an **Accountability Performance Value (APV)**, which gives you an overview of how the day went.

This value becomes increasingly valuable as you add more tasks for your team to be accountable for.

Over time, it helps you track productivity more effectively, especially as the volume of tasks grows, and keeping a clear overview of daily

performance becomes more challenging.

### Here's how to track progress with the tool:

- Enter “x” when your team successfully completes a task, duty, or process from the list. This will turn the box green, signifying completion.

- Enter “-” if the task, duty, or process was not completed for the day. This will turn the box red, indicating an area that needs attention.

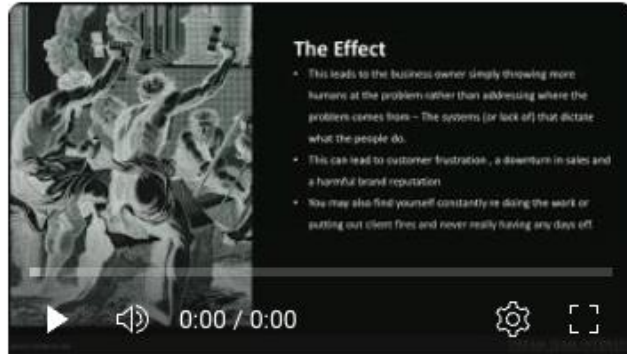

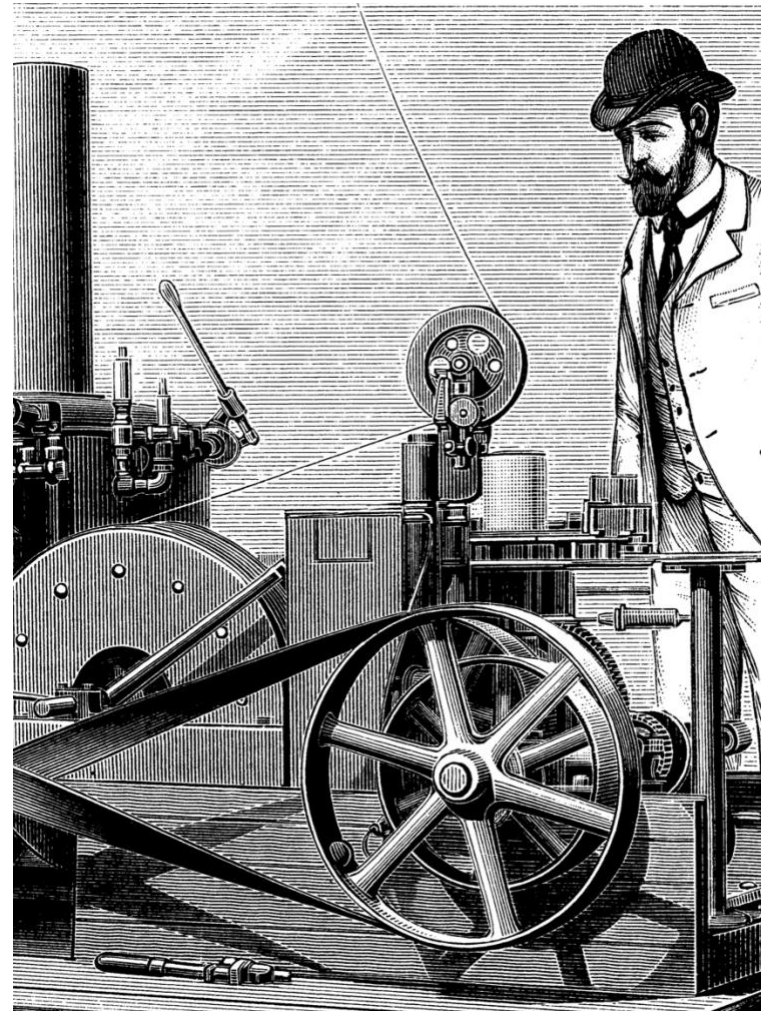
## IMPORTANT: Ramping Up Accountability

As your team gets into the rhythm of tracking their tasks, you'll notice a significant shift in how they approach their responsibilities.

The key to scaling any business efficiently is gradual accountability—building a culture where each individual understands their role, tracks their progress, and takes ownership without you needing to be the enforcer.

This is exactly how we work with our clients at **Systems and Teams** to create sustainable, high-performing teams—through proven methods like this accountability tracker.

Here's how you can build up accountability over time, just like many of our clients have done with us:





## 1) Start Small

In the beginning, focus on a few critical tasks that can be easily tracked. This gives your team the opportunity to establish consistency before introducing more complex tasks.

We recommend starting with simple, measurable goals that align directly with your business's core objectives—just like we guide our clients here at Systems and Teams during the early stages of training and process mapping.

## 2) Gradually Increase Responsibility

Once your team is consistently hitting green “x” marks, it’s time to shift your focus from what is being done to what isn’t being done.

The goal here is to find the holes in your processes—what is getting missed, rather than what is going well. If a task has been receiving a consistent 100% completion rate with all green “x” marks for several weeks in a row, then it's a sign that task is being effectively handled.

You can likely **stop tracking it** and let it continue running smoothly on autopilot.

instead, dedicating energy to areas that still require improvement or optimization.

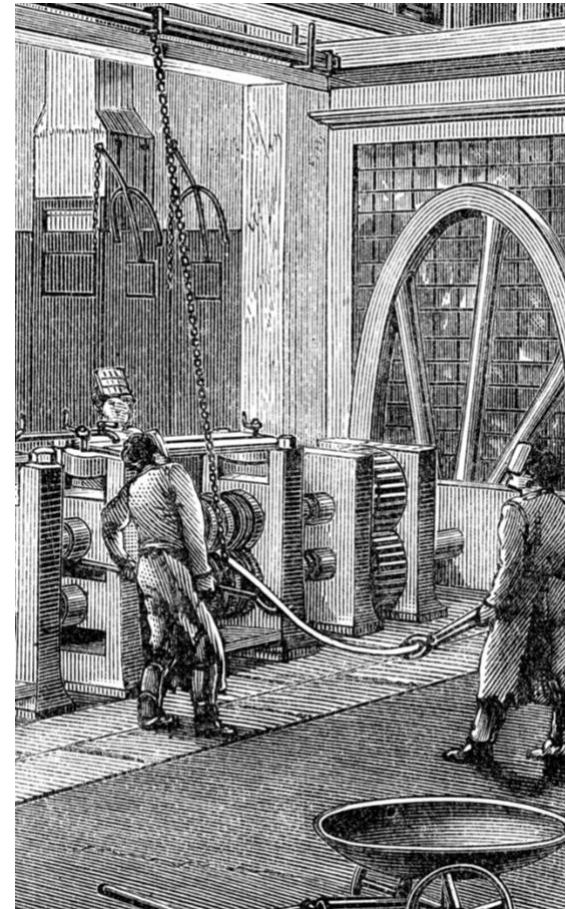
### 3) Weekly Reviews

Set aside time each week to review the tracker with your team—not to micromanage, but to clear the path for them **and make their jobs easier.**

If tasks aren't being completed or goals aren't being met, there's a reason—whether it's a process inefficiency, a lack of clarity, or a team structure that needs optimizing for better time management and throughput.

Leaders should focus on removing barriers rather than dictating every step of the process. Instead of asking, “Why wasn't this done?”, shift to “How can I help?”—this reframes the conversation from blame to problem-solving, allowing team members to openly discuss what's blocking them.

When leaders actively support their teams,



employees feel empowered to take ownership, problem-solve more effectively, and improve overall performance. At **Systems and Teams**, this is a critical part of the consulting process we provide to clients—empowering leaders to step back and allow their teams to thrive.

Did an issue in the morning snowball into missed tasks later in the day?

It's important to recognize that **it's never a "team problem"**—it's always a system, process, or leadership problem. If your team isn't completing tasks or meeting expectations, something upstream is causing the breakdown.

Are the roles clearly defined?

Are expectations realistic?

Are there gaps in training, documentation, or delegation?

Blaming the team only leads to frustration and resistance, while focusing on optimizing systems leads to real, lasting improvements.

This subtle but powerful shift moves the focus from blame to problem-solving, allowing you to refine systems rather than micromanage individuals.

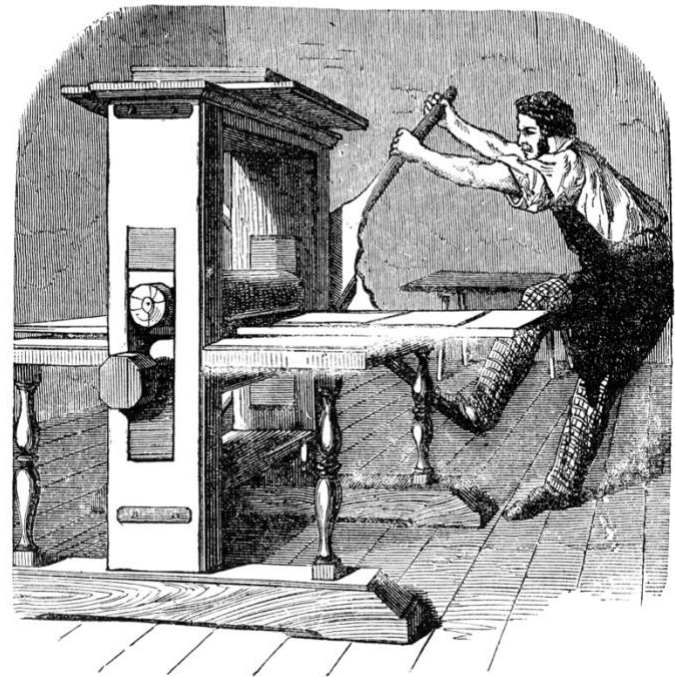
