

# Outdoor Service Plan

*Sunday, May 24<sup>th</sup>, 2020 from 10:00 AM to 11:00 AM*

## I. Procedures before the service

A. For any equipment and/or facilities that may be used during the church service:

1. All tents, tables, chairs, sound equipment, pulpits and instruments will be set up according to the CDC's guidelines for social distancing by members of our worship team.
2. All tents, tables, chairs, hymnals and sound equipment including PA speakers, speaker stands, cordless microphones and portable microphones will be disinfected according to the CDC's guidelines for sanitization by members of our worship team.

B. For anyone who attends the church service:

1. Attendees will be asked to park on the streets around the church property and to enter through the back gate on Drakeley Avenue.
2. Attendees will be directed where to go and how to maintain the CDC's guideline for social distancing by signage on the public sidewalk and on the pavement of the church parking lot.
3. Attendees will be greeted once they enter the church parking lot by two members of our worship team, who will:
  - a. Ask if they have been ill or if they have been around anyone who was ill recently.
  - b. Offer them a PPE to wear and hand sanitizer to use.
  - c. Take their temperature and record that it was taken.
4. Attendees will then be escorted to the designated seating area for their family by one of the members of our worship team.

## II. Procedures during the service

A. For speakers and members of the worship team:

1. Speakers, singing groups and instrumentalists will practice social distancing per the CDC's guidelines.
  - a. Speakers will be seated separately from members of the worship team.

- b. Singing groups will be comprised of members from the same family.
  2. Speakers and singing groups will not share cordless or portable microphones.
- B. For anyone who attends the service:
1. Attendees will be asked to refrain from embracing, shaking hands and other forms of physical contact.
  2. Attendees will not be asked to participate in any type of worship practice that contradicts the CDC's social distancing guidelines such as the passing of an offering plate or receiving of communion.
  3. Attendees with infants, small children or teenagers will be asked to monitor their children themselves without the assistance of a nursery.
  4. Attendees will be asked to help us avoid the use the church's restroom facilities by encouraging the members of their family to use restroom facilities at home before leaving to come to the church service.
    - ~ The church's two outdoor bathrooms will be available only for emergency purposes. These facilities will be sanitized prior to the service and will be sanitized immediately after the service if utilized at any time.

### III. Procedures after the service

- A. For anyone who attends the service:
1. Attendees will be escorted by a member of our worship team from their designated seating area to the exit one family at a time once the service has concluded.
  2. Attendees will be given the opportunity to:
    - a. Leave an offering in a basket by the exit
    - b. Use hand sanitizer as they leave
- B. For any equipment and/or facilities that may be used during the church service:
1. All tents, tables, chairs, hymnals and sound equipment including PA speakers, speaker stands, cordless microphones and portable microphones will be disinfected according to the CDC's guidelines for sanitization by members of our worship team.
  2. All tents, tables, chairs, sound equipment, pulpits and instruments will be stored inside the church building by members of our worship team.
