



The Regen Academy FAQs

- **What is the Regen Academy?**
A global digital platform offering practical, evidence-informed learning on regenerative agriculture, rooted in real-world examples and anchored in [Integrated Farm Management](#).
- **Why is LEAF launching this now?**
Demand is growing for clear, credible guidance that that helps farmers make decisions and potentially explore techniques with greater confidence. The Academy will make trusted peer learning easier to access and more globally relevant.
- **Who is it for?**
The goal is to make regenerative farming inclusive – attracting like-minded farmers, advisers and the wider food supply chain that wants credible, farm-led learning and a trusted place to engage.
- **Is LEAF defining what “regen” means?**
No. [Six regenerative farming principles](#) are already widely agreed. The Academy will highlight how regenerative principles are being applied in practice in different contexts, allowing farmers to explore, interpret and adapt them to their own systems.
- **How is this different from other regen content?**
The Regen Academy will create an inclusive global academy. It will bring together credible farmer-led insights, content based on robust scientific evidence and commercial-scale examples – all built on LEAF’s long-established approach to peer-to-peer learning and demonstration.
- **Is LEAF switching from IFM to regen?**
No. IFM and continuous improvement remain our anchor. The Regen Academy will explore regenerative principles through that lens. LEAF’s overall approach remains anchored in IFM through robust management planning and the measurement of continuous improvement; we see these approaches aligning with our overarching model of sustainable agriculture.
- **Will the Academy tell farmers what to do?**
No. We support informed decision-making, grounded in context and peer learning.
- **Will there be accreditation?**
In year one, the focus will be largely on case studies and webinars. More structured courses and additional training pathways are expected to roll out from year two onwards, with accreditation being explored as a possibility in future years.
- **How much will it cost to enrol?**
LEAF Members will have free access to the platform. Others may pay a fee, with additional resources becoming available depending on funding. These models will be decided later in 2026 – but the goal is to keep this learning hub as widely accessible as possible.

When does it launch?

Our intention is that the Regen Academy will launch later in 2026, with more resources and functionality being added in phases from that point onwards. The Academy community will share what works, where, when and why, including the trade-offs – continuing LEAF’s tradition of supporting informed decision-making, grounded in context and peer learning.
