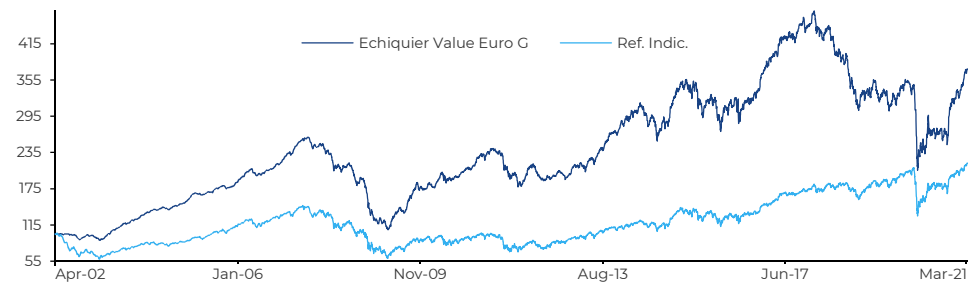
Fund Manager comments

Echiquier Value Euro G turned in a positive monthly performance of 7.64% and of 15.35% year-to-date.

Inflation expectations remain high, with an annual increase that could reach more than 3% in a few weeks – a level not seen for the past decade. In such conditions, US yields continued their ascent to 1.7% at the end of the month, compared with 0.3% at the height of the health crisis. In our view, this rapid and significant rise poses a threat to assets with a longer duration, while shorter-duration securities, often associated with the value sphere and the victims of falling interest rates for many years, are set to benefit from this rebalancing. The anticipated return of inflation also reflects the prospect of global growth boosted by unprecedented fiscal policies, particularly in the US. Sectors sensitive to the macroeconomic situation (steel, construction, energy) and to the reopening of economies (tourism, specialised distribution), to which the fund is significantly exposed, thus posted the month's best performances. In this favourable environment for value management, the fund outperformed eurozone equities.

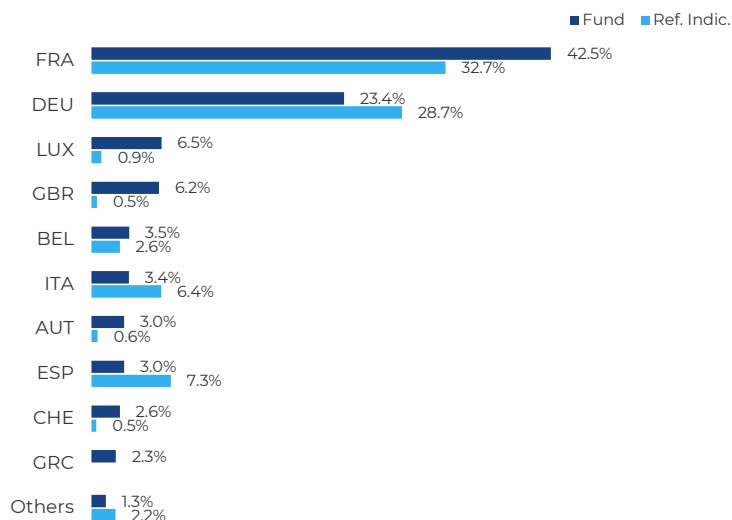

Geographic breakdown

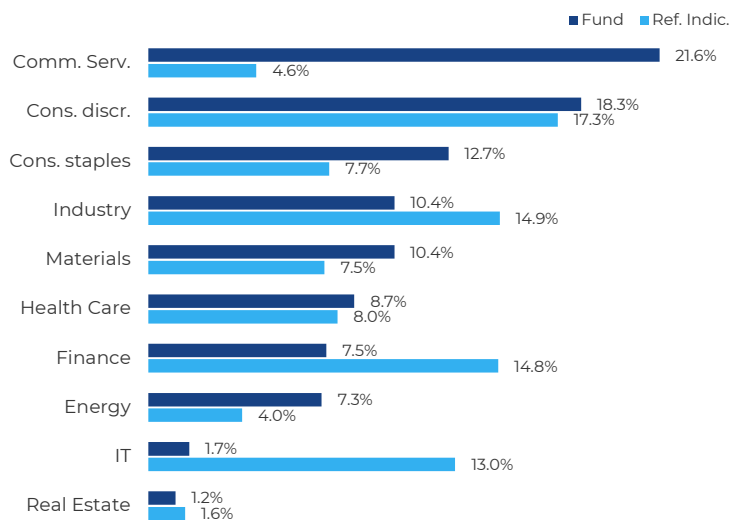
(% of the net assets without cash)

Sector breakdown (GICS)

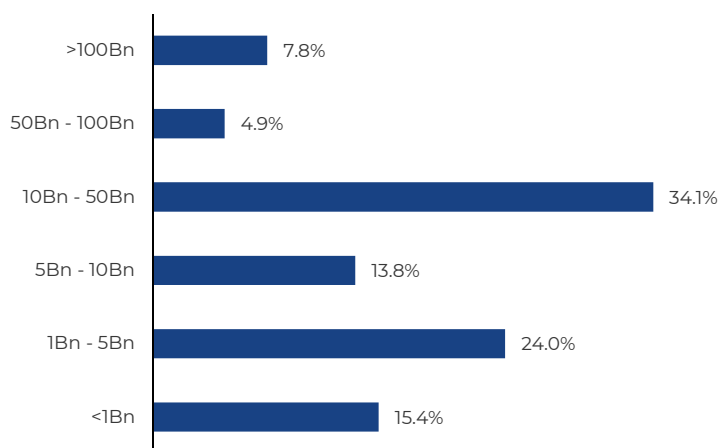
