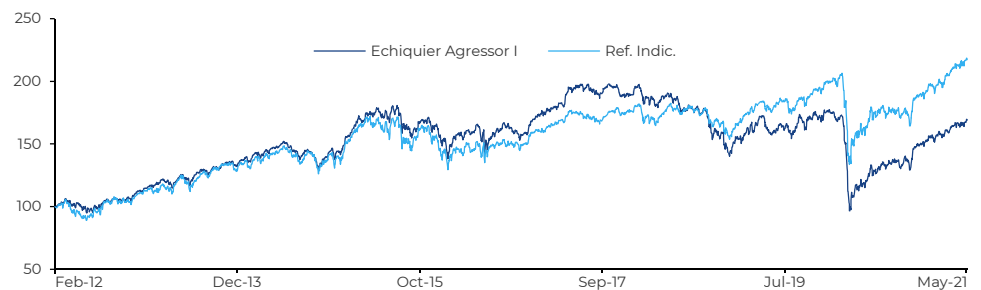
Fund Manager comments

Echiquier Agressor I turned in a positive monthly performance of 2.47% and of 11.20% year-to-date.

Financial markets continued to perform well in May as economic indicators improved. Economies are gradually reopening thanks to the success of vaccination campaigns in the major developed countries, suggesting a rapid exit from the crisis and a rebound in consumption as early as this summer. The only cause for concern is inflation, which is starting to be felt at different levels of the value chain. The continuing accommodative rhetoric of central banks is convincing, but the level of volatility is a sign of nervousness. In this context, Echiquier Agressor managed to capture most of the increase thanks to its exposure to companies sensitive to the reopening of economies, such as AIRBUS. Companies linked to the end consumer, such as KERING or MONCLER, also performed well. Banks were among the top contributors to the portfolio, with the latter benefiting directly from the rise in interest rates. Finally, companies suffering from rising commodity costs, such as industrial firms, and rising rates, such as technology and renewable energy specialists, underperformed in May.

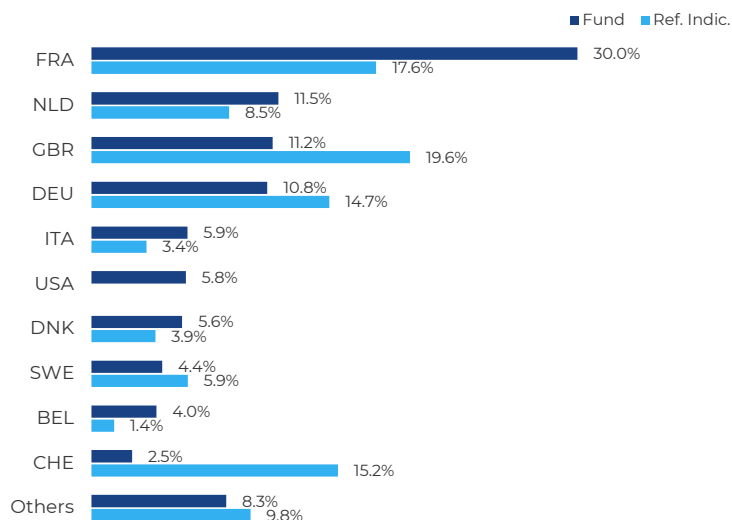

Geographic breakdown

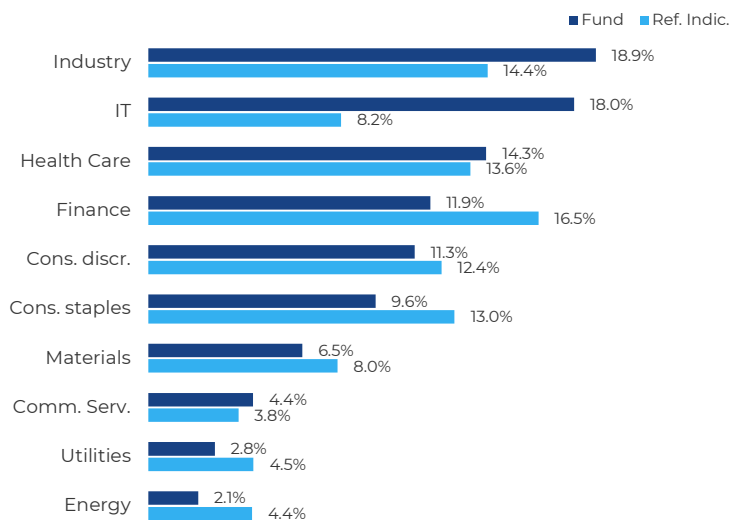
(% of the net assets without cash)

Sector breakdown (GICS)

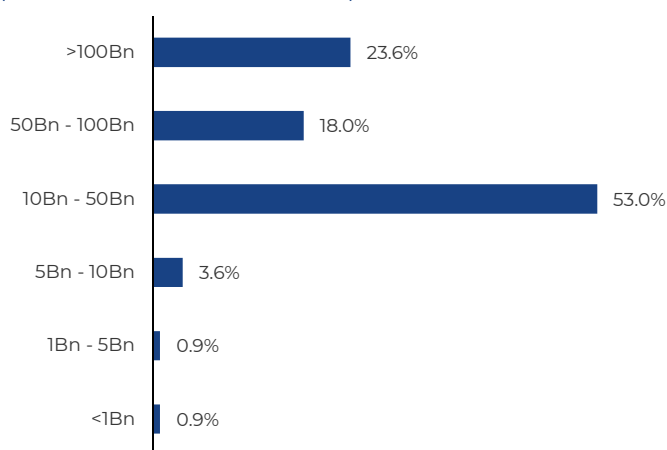
