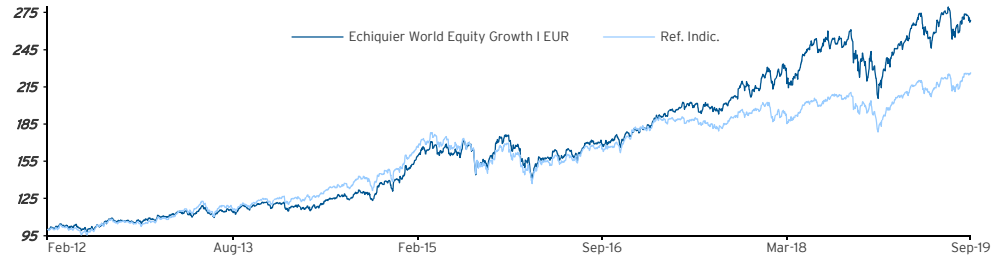
Fund Manager comments

“ Echiquier World Equity Growth I EUR turned in a 0.34% monthly performance and a 22.86% performance year to date.

September saw markets look normal, even though there was nothing normal about a month that saw Saudi oil facilities attacked, a rumor that Chinese stocks could be de-listed from American exchanges, problems with liquidity in the repo and money fund markets and the beginning of an impeachment inquiry in the US. There were no significant changes to the fund during the month. Some of the best performances for the fund came from a market rotation into companies like our cyclical leaders Caterpillar and Nidec, and our financials, such as Blackrock, Brazilian bank Itau Unibanco, and Singapore bank OCBC. Meanwhile the market rotation out of growth meant that some of our strongest year-to-date performers, such as Alibaba, Salesforce, Visa and Mastercard, were laggards for September. Our strategy going forward in a world full of macro uncertainty is to maintain our focus on the best growth companies.

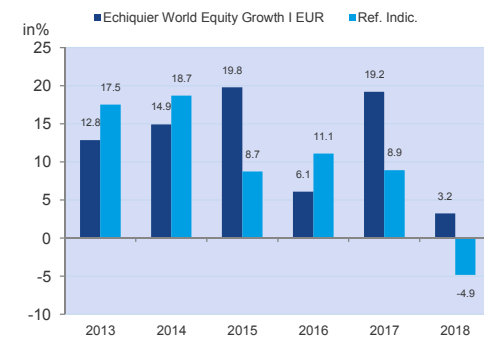

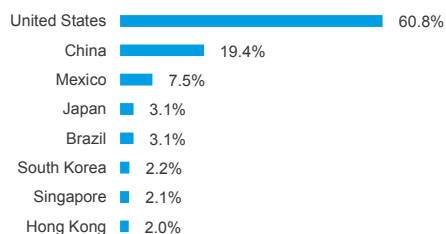

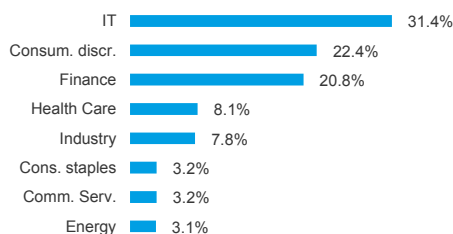

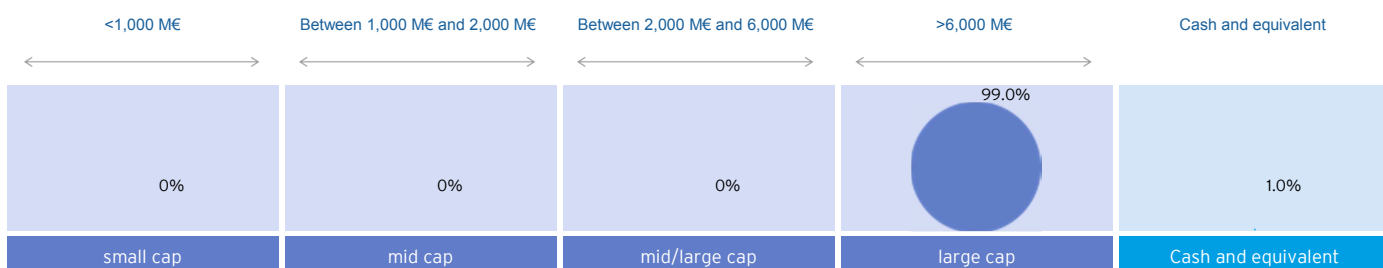
Geographic breakdown
