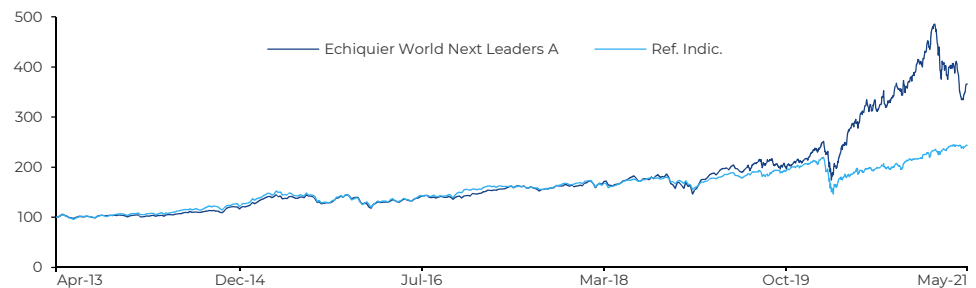
Fund Manager comments

Echiquier World Next Leaders A turned in a negative monthly performance of -6.64% and of -10.98% year-to-date.

The rotation in favour of the most cyclical stocks or those benefiting from the reopening of the economy resumed in May, negatively impacting the fund. Its positioning on the themes of the future via medium-sized companies leads us towards high-growth stocks that are often not very cyclical. Despite the high monthly volatility, we see encouraging signs going forward. The growth prospects of our companies have never been stronger or more visible. Their capacity to constantly innovate means that the demand for their products or services is far from subdued. An example is the Swedish stock SINCH, one of the leaders in cloud communication platforms, which saw its revenue more than double thanks to recent acquisitions while also posting organic growth of +38%. Another promising performer is WUXI BIOLOGICS, a Chinese company which develops drugs based on biological molecules that represent the next generation of medical therapies for a growing number of diseases. Our confidence in a future shaped by innovation and the emergence of future economic leaders is higher than ever.

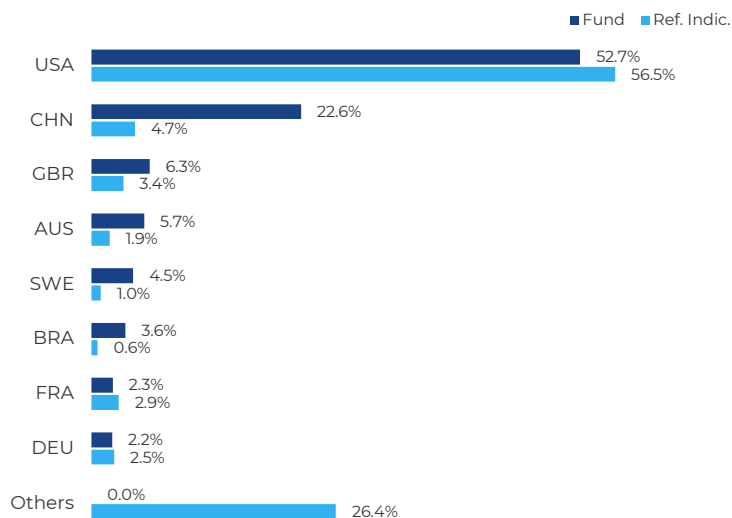

Geographic breakdown

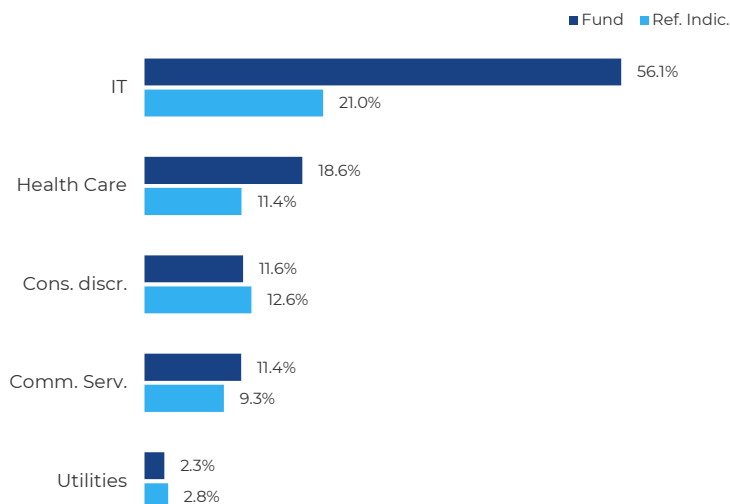
(% of the net assets without cash)

Sector breakdown (GICS)

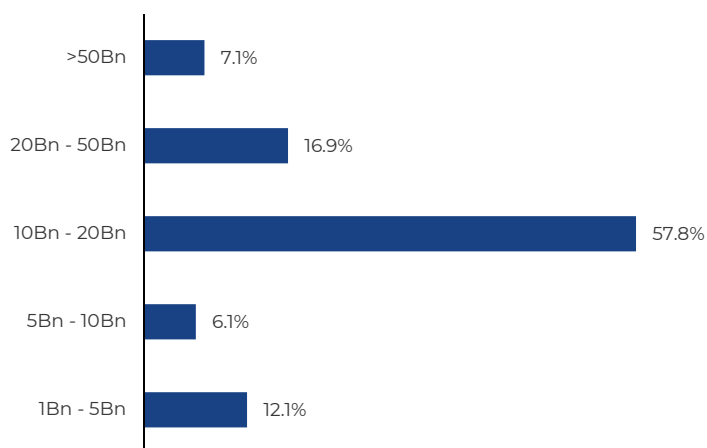
