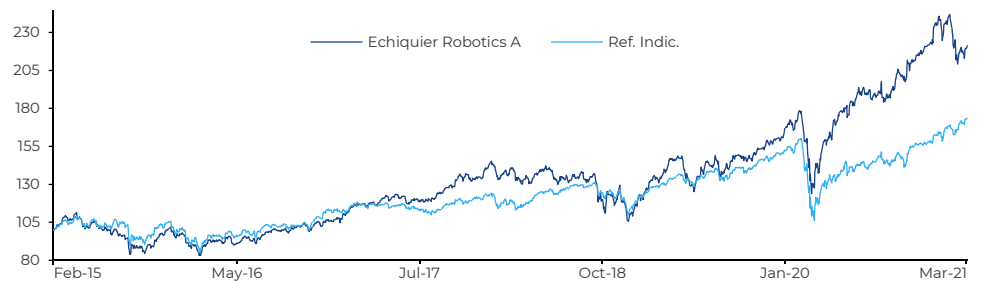
Fund Manager comments

Echiquier Robotics A turned in a positive monthly performance of 0.71% and turned in a negative performance of -1.05% year-to-date.

The strong rotation of styles between structural growth stocks and cyclical companies or companies benefiting from the reopening of the economy accelerated in March. The fund was negatively impacted by its exposure to structural growth stocks such as TWILIO, ALTERYX and INTUITIVE SURGICAL. Our vision of digital robotisation allowed us to diversify into less cyclical holdings, many of which were sold by the market in March. Nonetheless, we remain very confident that better times lie ahead for these companies, which have a very high structural growth profile and the ability to deliver equally high levels of profitability. Among the positive performers were robotics companies most exposed to the industrial and automotive sectors, which should see sustained demand following the negative effects of the COVID-19 crisis in 2020. The most notable were Japanese company THK, whose linear modules are used in many industrial robots, and automation firm DAIFUKU, which is particularly active in logistics and e-commerce.

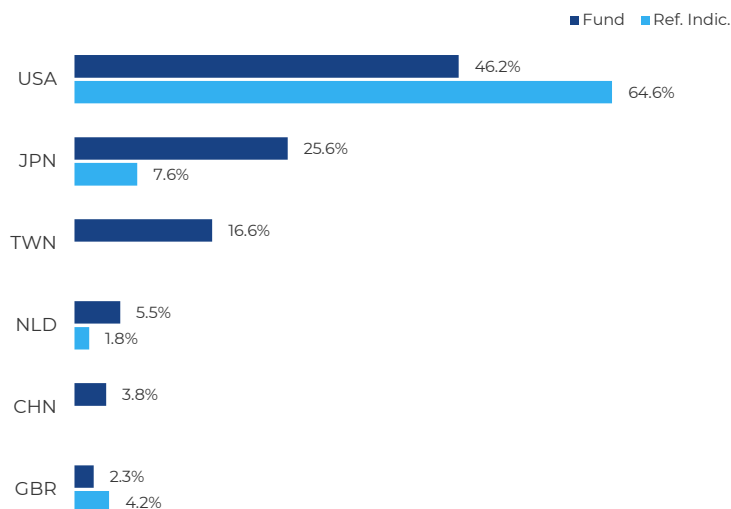

Geographic breakdown

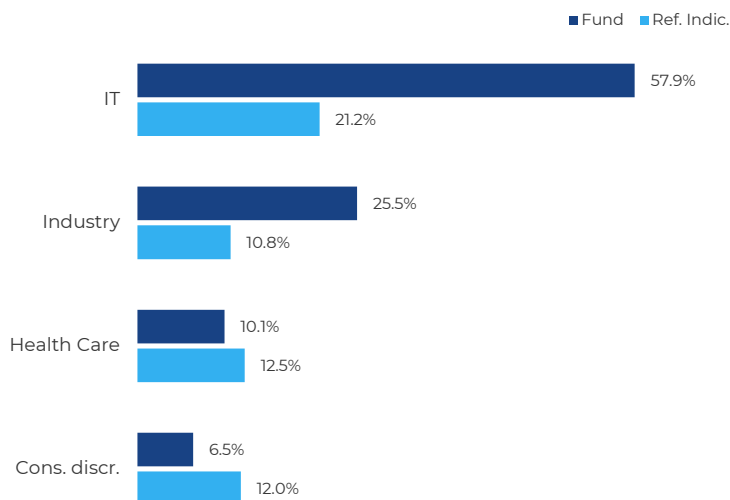
(% of the net assets without cash)

Sector breakdown (GICS)

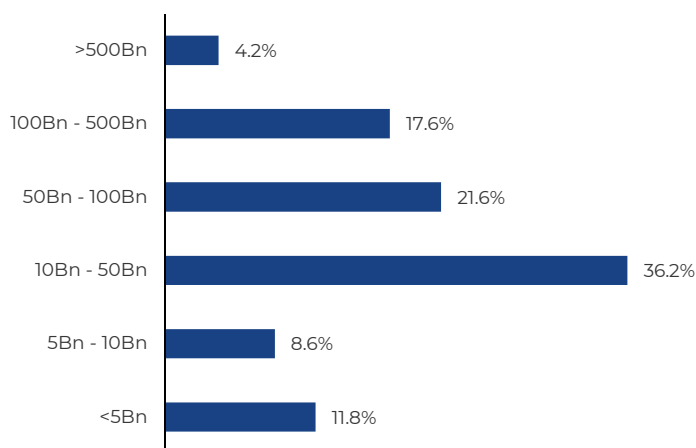
