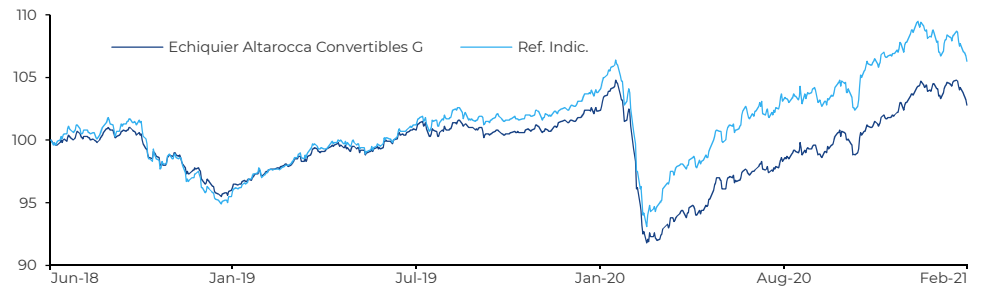
Fund Manager comments

Echiquier AltaRocca Convertibles G turned in a negative monthly performance of -0.53% and of -0.84% year-to-date.

The month of February saw the spectre of inflation resurface, resulting in a significant rise in long-term rates fed, among other things, by good micro and macroeconomic figures, reassuring news on the epidemic front and the progress of stimulus plans across the Atlantic. Convertible bonds fell as a consequence, suffering from their sensitivity to interest rates and the relative weight of growth stocks that particularly underperformed. The fund held up well thanks to its contained duration and "cyclical" allocation driven by stocks such as SIEMENS, which published excellent results and whose exchangeable was the subject of a buyback offer from its issuer. We continued to rebalance the fund by reducing our exposure to stocks sensitive to the "stay at home" theme and which were weakened by the continued rise in interest rates, such as DELIVERY HERO and ZALANDO. The primary market remains very active with 4.3 billion of issues. These include the NEXI convertible in which we participated, convinced by its positioning in a market that is growing and constantly consolidating and which should make it a future European leader in payments.

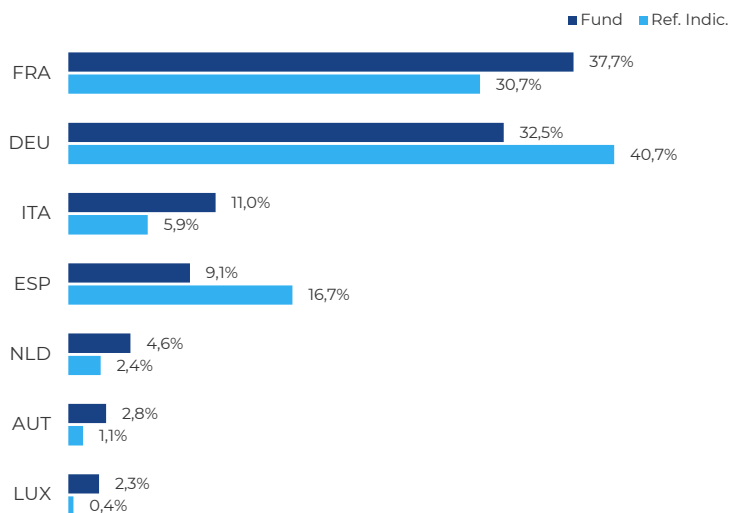

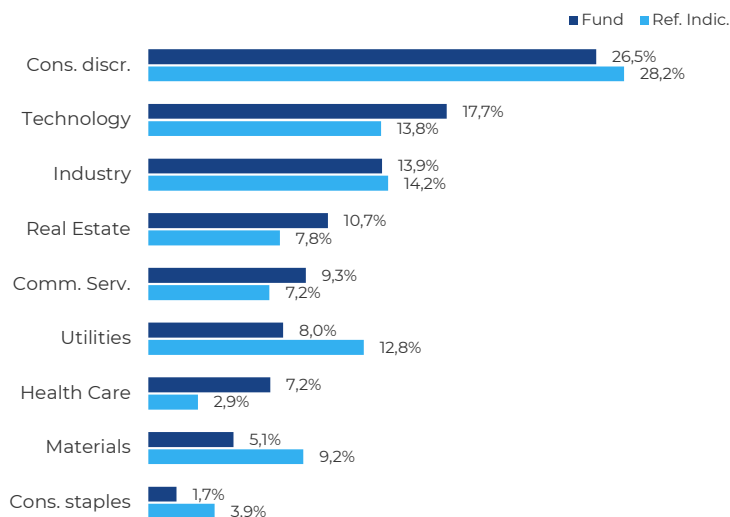

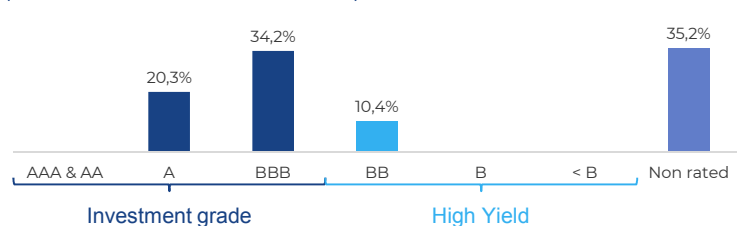

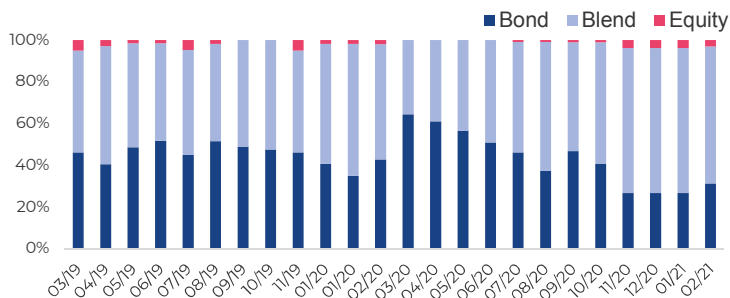
Rating breakdown
