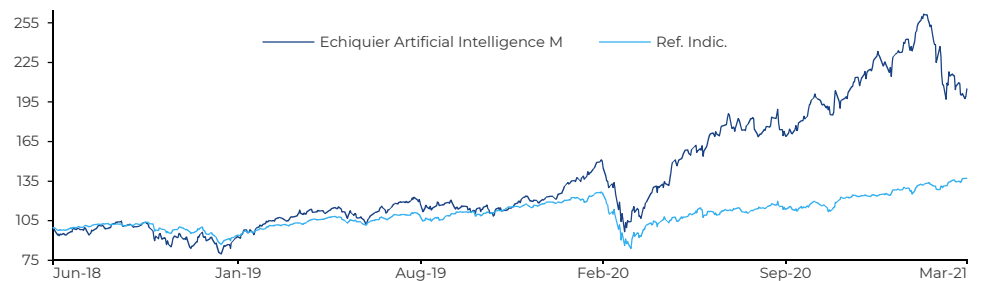
Fund Manager comments

Echiquier Artificial Intelligence M turned in a negative monthly performance of -9.93% and of -8.23% year-to-date.

The economic recovery continued as vaccination campaigns progressed, particularly in the United States. At the same time, the US fiscal stimulus led to fears of strong inflation, which prompted many investors to rotate their portfolios in favour of companies more exposed to the economic cycle or to the reopening of the economy. This rotation negatively impacted the fund, which is focused on high-growth companies that benefit from or enable the rise of artificial intelligence. In particular, companies such as C3.ai registered sharp declines, which enabled us to launch a position in the portfolio. Finally, we saw that the march towards the digital transformation of our economy is accelerating. The return of a revitalised economy will favour giving even more impetus to our companies, whose growth is structural. Now more than ever, we believe the growth prospects for our theme are high, and we eagerly await the quarterly results of the companies in our portfolio, which we expect will remind the markets of their major strengths.

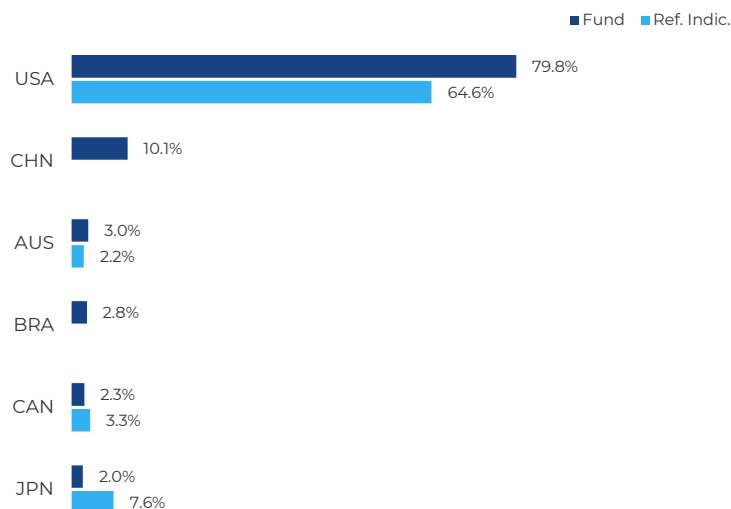

Geographic breakdown

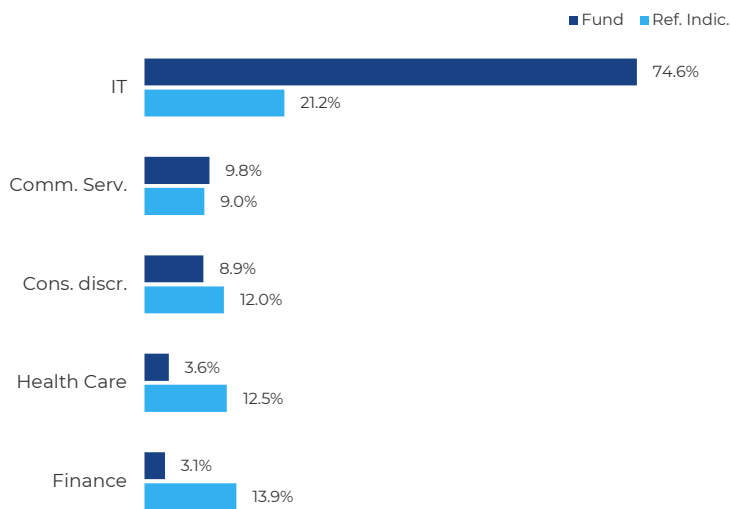
(% of the net assets without cash)

Sector breakdown (GICS)

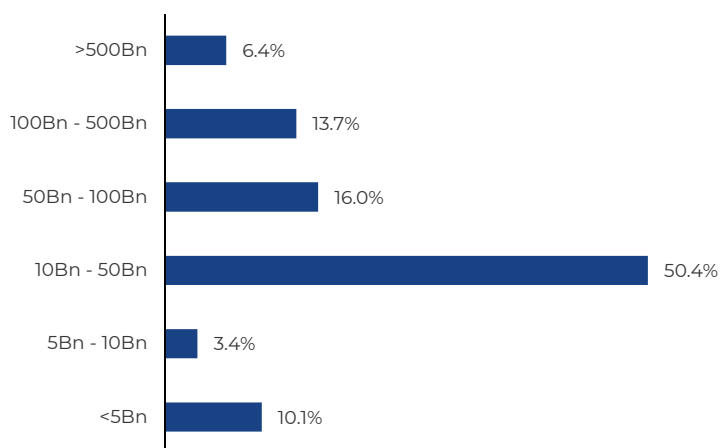
