

Litir do Luchd-ionnsachaidh

An Ranger agus Black 47

Each week the West Highland Free Press publishes the text for Ruairidh's "Letter to Gaelic Learners" on BBC Radio nan Gàidheal (103.5-105 FM). Am faca sibh riamh am film, *An Ranger?* Chaidh a dhèanamh ann an 2008 agus tha e ann an Gàidhlig na h-Èireann air fad. Gheibhear e air YouTube. Chan eil e ach deich mionaidean a dh'fhaid, agus saoilidh mi gu bheil e air a dhèanamh gu math. Tha fo-thiotalan Beurla air, ach do luchd-labhairt Gàidhlig na h-Alba, tha e furasta gu leòr a thuigsinn às aonais nam fo-thiotalan.

Tha am film mu dheidhinn saighdear Èireannach – Gàidheal à Conamara – a tha a' tilleadh dhachaigh, an dèidh a bhith thall thairis, ann an seirbheis na h-Ìmpireachd, fad bliadhna air fhichead. Nuair a ruigeas e a sheann dachaigh, chan eil mullach air. Chan eil sgeul air duine beò. Agus tha mucan a' fuireach anns an tobhta.

Tha an saighdear air a sgreamhachadh.

Fhad 's a bha e air falbh, bha gort a' bhuntàta ann. Rinn sin sgrios air feadh taobh an iar na h-Èireann. Bha fuadaichean ann cuideachd. Thill ar caraid dhachaigh sa bhliadhna ochd ceud deug, caogad 's a ceithir (1854).

Tha e a' dol gu taigh co-ogha a mhàthar – am fear leis a bheil na mucan. Tha an co-ogha a' cur na coire airson na thachair air na Sasannaich – agus Albannach no dhà. Bha màthair an t-saighdeir air a fuadachadh às a dachaigh, agus chaochail i ann an taigh nam bochd.

Ach chan eil an saighdear a' gabhail ri leisgeul an duine eile. Tha e a' toirt sgian mhòr a-mach – khukuri a fhuair e ann an Àisia. Tha e a' dol a dh'fhaighinn dioghaltas air an fheadhainn a rinn sgrios air a theaghach. Airson a' chòrr, feumaidh sibh am film fhaicinn!

'S dòcha gum bi feedhainn agaibh ag ràdh – ist, a Ruairidh, tha thu a' bruidhinn air a' film *Black 47* a nochd air sgàileanan mòra an t-saoghal an-uiridh. Agus bhiodh sibh ceart. Bha *Black 47* stèidhichte air *An Ranger* – ged a tha e mòran nas fhaide, agus a' toirt a-steach murt is marbhadh nach eil a' nochdadadh sa film ghoirid Ghaeilge. Agus tha e a' tachairt seachd bliadhna roimhe, ann an ochd ceud deug, ceathrad 's a seachd (1847).

Nam biodh sibh a' coimhead airson film a tha làn ábhachdais is fealla-dhà, cha mholainn *Black 47* dhuibh. Tha e gu math dorch, dòrainneach. Ach **tha e air a dheagh dhèanamh**. Agus thug e toileachas dhomh na bh' ann de Ghàidhlig na h-Èireann ann.

Cha chreid mi gun robh blas Chonamara aig a h-uile duine a bha a' bruidhinn 'as Gaeilge' ach, a dh'aindeoin sin, saoilidh mi gun do rinn an cleasaiche a chluich an caractar aig meadhan a' ghnothaich – an seann saighdear, O Fiannaidhe – sioba mhath

dheth. Cha robh facal Gaeilge aige mus do thòisich e air a' phròiseact. Chan eil e Èireannach, gu dearbh, ach Astràilianach. 'S e Seumas Frecheville an t-ainm a th' air.

An àite a bhith a' toirt a' chreidsinn gun robh Beurla aig a h-uile duine – *à la* Braveheart – bha aon charactar na eadar-theangair a thug taic do shaighdearan Sasannach a bha an tòir air O Fiannaidhe. Agus leig sin le muinntir Chonamara a bhith a' bruidhinn nan cànan fhèin sa film. Dh'obraich sin gu math agus tha mi an dòchas – an ath thuras a bhios film eachdraidheil stèidhichte air Gàidhealtachd na h-Alba – gum bi a h-àite aig a' Ghàidhlig mar bu chòir.

Faclan na Litreach: fo-thiotalan: *subtitles*; thall thairis: *overseas*; fuadaichean: *clearances*; dòrainneach: *harrowing*; Astràilianach: *Australian*; eadar-theangair: *interpreter, translator*; O Fiannaidhe: *Feeney*.

Abairtean na Litreach: fad bliadhna thar fhichead: *for 21 years*; nuair a ruigeas e a sheann dachaigh, chan eil mullach air: *when he reaches his old home, it is roofless*; chan eil sgeul air duine beò: *there is no sign of a living person*; tha mucan a' fuireach anns an tobhta: *pigs are living in the ruins*; fhad 's a bha e air falbh, bha gort a' bhuntàta ann: *while he was away, the potato famine occurred*; tha an co-ogha a' cur na coire airson na thachair air na Sasannaich: *the cousin blames the English for what happened*; bha màthair an t-saighdeir air a fuadachadh às a dachaigh, agus chaochail i ann an taigh nam bochd: *the soldier's mother was cleared from her home, and she died in the poorhouse*; nam biodh sibh a' coimhead airson film a tha làn àbhachdais is fealla-dhà, cha mholainn X: *if you were looking for a film that is full of humour and fun, I wouldn't recommend X*; thug e toileachas dhomh na bh' ann de Ghàidhlig na h-Èireann ann: *it pleased me how much Irish Gaelic was in it*; saoilidh mi gun do rinn an cleasaiche a chluich an charactar aig meadhan a' ghnothaich sioba mhath: *I reckon the actor that played the character at the heart of the affair did a good job*; cha robh facal Gaeilge aige mus do thòisich e air a' phròiseact: *he didn't speak a word of Irish Gaelic before he started on the project*; an àite a bhith a' toirt a' chreidsinn gun robh Beurla aig a h-uile duine: *instead of pretending that everybody spoke English*; a bha an tòir air X: *who were pursuing X*; leig sin le muinntir Chonamara a bhith a' bruidhinn nan cànan fhèin: *this allowed the people of Connemara to speak in their own language*; dh'obraich sin gu math: *that worked well*; an ath thuras a bhios film eachdraidheil stèidhichte air Gàidhealtachd na h-Alba: *the next time there is a historical film based in the Highlands of Scotland*; gum bi a h-àite aig a' Ghàidhlig mar bu chòir: *that Gaelic will have its place as it should*.

Puing-chànan na Litreach: *tha e air a dheagh dhèanamh*: *it is well made. This is a development of tha e air a dhèanamh, and an alternative to tha e air a dhèanamh gu math. Here's another example: chaidh a dheagh thogail 'he was raised well'; chaidh a dheagh sgrìobhadh 'it was well written'.*

Gnàthas-cainnt na Litreach: *Tha an saighdear air a sgreamhachadh*: *the soldier is sickened.*
